
#### **Featured Service**

## Safety First

Last week we announced on our social media channels, and webpage, that we ceased all onsite operations until after April 6. This was a responsible decision we made in an effort to protect the health of our community. In that time we've received a number of inquiries related to overgrown grass, the start of *Full Service Landscape Maintenance*, large project launch dates, etc. Please know that we're monitoring each individual assignment and in the coming weeks we'll begin to send out a limited amount of workers to commence service. When doing so we'll participate in industry best practices outlined by governing officials. We'll get verbal/written approval to work from clients, obey distancing regulations, utilize only one on-site worker, always stay outside and limit the amount of persons in company vehicles. We'll also take the temperature of every employee before each day of work and follow the *Wage and Hour Division of the U.S. Department of Labor* 'Qualifying Reasons For Leave.' We remind everyone that the *Ohio Department of Health* outlined the following:

"The lawn care, turfgrass maintenance and landscape industry professionals are protectors of public health performing essential treatments and mowing to lawns and green spaces to reduce the transmission of dangerous and deadly diseases through pests like mosquitoes, ticks, fleas and rodents. Also, healthy turfgrass means a healthy environment. Studies revealed that healthy turf filters pollutants from rainfall that prevents them from running off into drinking water sources."
